Terms & Conditions for North America

USA/Canada

Within USA and Canada, the ECOBULK will be collected free of charge within 7 days, with a minimum quantity of 8 ECOBULK in the USA and a minimum of 10 ECOBULK in Canada. Pickups are made only within continental USA and continental Canada.

A surcharge of \$14.00 CDN per IBC will be levied in Western Canada, British Columbia, Alberta, Saskatchewan and Manitoba. Additional disposal costs may apply. Toxic 6.1 and Marine Pollutants (as listed in 49CFR 172.101 appendix B) must be triple rinsed.

General Terms & Conditions

1. All IBCs must be SCHÜTZ totes. The "SCHÜTZ" logo must appear embedded in the metal name plate.
2. All IBCs must be less than 18 months old.
3. All IBCs must be empty of product.
4. No severe residue or oxidation on inside or outside of container, No damage to inner bottle, cages or pallets (not bent or broken). Metal cages MUST be re-usable.

Conditions for collection of IBC

- SCHÜTZ TICKET validation
 - valid for all SCHÜTZ ECOBULK sold directly to the filler by SCHÜTZ, emptied after the initial fill.
 - Only SCHÜTZ ECOBULK will be collected.
- Condition of the ECOBULK
 - ECOBULK has to be intact, i.e. no damage to the innerbottle, steel cage or other integral parts of the containers and no severe oxidation on the outside.
 - Valves and/or other closures have to be operable and in place. For transportation each empty ECOBULK has to be closed like a filled ECOBULK.

Conditions for collection of IBC

Filling goods

- have to be emptied completely
(low viscosity: 0.1 % of volume,
high viscosity: 0.5 % of volume)
- must not be hazardous to health or environment or
belong to class R45/R49 or Mutagenic Cat.1 or
Carcinogenic Cat.1



Inner bottle, steel cage, pallets

- have to be intact and must not have severe oxidation

Conditions for collection of IBC

Correct markings

- Label plates, product labels and hazardous material labels have to be readable
- emptied and uncleaned ECOBULK have to be marked and labelled (UN-Number and chemical name) and must be provided with the same dangerous good stickers as filled ECOBULK



TICKET SERVICE

Conditions for collection of IBC

Valves and other closures

- have to be operable and in place
- each empty ECOBULK has to be closed like a filled ECOBULK




Ticket Fax

- number of indicated IBCs has to correspond to the number of IBCs ready for pick-up at the emptiers site
- has to be signed



Ticket Service

- Completing and returning the TICKET FAX
 - Simply complete the SCHÜTZ TICKET FAX with the exact required information and forward it to the nearest SCHÜTZ TICKET administration centre.
 - All valid rules, conditions and requirements of the collection service are listed on the SCHÜTZ TICKET FAX.
 - Latest SCHÜTZ TICKET conditions are listed on the SCHÜTZ Website.
